Dear Parents and Guardians,

The summer months are flying by and I hope you, and the soon to be Brookfield High School student at your home, are in good spirits and excited for the upcoming school year. This letter is your formal invitation to our orientation for new students on <u>Tuesday</u>, <u>August 25</u>, <u>2015 at 9:00 A.M.</u> in the Brookfield High School auditorium.
