### What is the MBR?

MBR = <u>Minimum Budget Requirement</u>

**Authorized by the State Legislature Section 154 of Public Act 13-247** 

**Establishes Legal Minimum Funding Levels for BOE Budgets** 

Reauthorized Annually

## Calculating the MBR?

#### **MBR Has A Number of Components:**

- A 2013-14 BOE Appropriation
- **B** Adjustments to the ECS Grant

$$A + B = 2014-15 \text{ MBR Base}$$

- **C** Enrollment Change Reductions
- **D** Efficiency Reductions

MBR = (MBR Base)-(C OR D)

# Fewer Students \* \$3,000
