The administrative council serves in an advisory capacity as the cabinet of the superintendent. The team assists in the long-range clarification of objectives, identification of problems, establishment of priorities, development of strategies and evaluation of the district's progress, as well as monitoring the day-to-day operations of the school system.

The administrative council serves in a communicative and interpretative capacity explaining the district's goals, procedures and policies to the staff and community.

The administrative council is composed of the superintendent, business manager, directors, principals, and other administrative personnel designated by the superintendent. They meet on a regular basis and are on call to the superintendent at any time.
