The Superintendent said the Board of Education's Adopted Budget went to the Board of Selectmen. An overview was provided of the request, particularly those items related to the 5.92% increase. Much of the discussion centered on the Special Education area and Charlie did an excellent job in furnishing pertinent follow-up information.

He congratulated the Brookfield Dance Team for their outstanding winning performance at the SWC Dance Championships. Special thanks and much appreciation to Deanne Petricionne and Assistant Isabel Mouthrop.

Mr. Iassogna also gave congratulations to the following recipients of Brookfield Education Foundation Grants:

- BHS support of its Personal Finance Class- over \$5,500..
- HHES “Fit Club” : a before-school fitness program championed by PE teacher Matthew Cudney: \$2,200
- WMS “Confessions of a Former Bully”: a collaboration with the health and literacy departments designed around the core curriculum, working to proactively teach 5th graders about bullying. Championed by curriculum specialist Aggie Burns: \$2,160.40
- Brookfield CARES: \$5,200 for facilitator’s fees for the first year of support group meetings.

## **OLD BUSINESS**

### **2015-2016 BUDGET**

The Board had a brief discussion on where the budget process is at this point. The Board of Education presented its budget to the Board of Selectmen.

P. Checco moved, V. Katz seconded and the Board voted 7-0 to add an Item #14, Discussion of Special Appropriation to this part of the meeting.

S. McCarthy, P. Checco, S. Queenan, H. Shaker, V. Katz, S. Harding and T. Lerner voted aye.

Chairman McCarthy gave an overview of the Special Appropriation.

After discussion- P. Checco moved, V. Katz seconded, and the Board voted 7-0 to direct Chairman McCarthy to request a Memorandum of Understanding to be signed by First Selectman Tinsley stating that the Town of Brookfield commits to covering \$123,387 (\$90,000 medical costs and \$33,387 workers compensation benefits).
