OLD BUSINESS

2014-2015 BUDGET DISCUSSION

Mr. Iassogna reported that the district potentially faces a projected \$400,000 deficit in the 2014-2015 school year. To help offset that possibility, Mr. Iassogna proposed imposing an immediate spending freeze, as well as seeking a supplemental appropriation from the Town to cover legal costs associated with unanticipated legal expenses. A discussion ensued. The spending freeze will be implemented immediately and the supplemental appropriation will be discussed further.

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2015-2016 BUDGET DISCUSSION

Mr. Iassogna provided the Board with an overview as to how he would present the 2015-2016 budget. He cited that the principals and department heads will present their respective budgets and answer any questions the Board may have. The Superintendent stated that the Budget Book will be streamlined and user-friendly; and will reflect what the district actually needs and not what it wants or wishes to have.

The 2013 IRS audit will begin December 8th.
