

## **2022-2023 SCHOOL LUNCH UPDATE- August, 2022**

Dear Parents and Guardians:

During the transition back to normal school operations in school year 2022-23, Brookfield Public Schools have opted into the federally funded School Meals Assistance Revenue for Transition (SMART) funds providing lunch at no cost for all students at the beginning of the school year. Please note that meals at no cost to all students are unlikely to last all year and are subject to the availability of district funds. Since the availability of meals at no cost will expire when all funds have been expended, it is critical that households submit a free and reduced-priced meal application as soon as possible to determine a student's eligibility for this school year and avoid unpaid meal charges.
