We understand that the 1:1 electronic device program is an important part of the School's overall academic and instructional program and it is our choice to supply our own electronic device.

Rights

- If the student's privately-owned device is lost or stolen, the family assumes all financial responsibility for the device.
- Students will be able to receive education-related apps from the school on their privately-owned device.
- Students should only access the school's wireless network with their privately owned device for educational purposes.
- Families will be exempt from all fees associated with the use of a school-owned device.

Responsibilities

- Students are expected to bring their privately-owned device to school every day and fully charged. The school cannot provide a loaner device or chargers should a student forget to bring their device.
- The family is responsible for hardware support and maintenance of the privately-owned device.
- Students must have all apps and accessories required by their teachers.

Smartphones are NOT an option for daily use in classes.
