Code of Ethics

An effective educational program requires the services of men and women of integrity, high ideals, and human understanding. To maintain and promote these essentials, all employees and volunteers of the Brookfield Public Schools are expected to maintain high standards in their school relationships. These standards include the following:

The establishment and maintenance of just and courteous professional relationships with pupils, parents, staff members, and others.

The transaction of all official business with the properly designated authorities of the school system.

The establishment and maintenance of cooperation between the community and the school system.

The recognition that the welfare of children as is the first concern of the school system.

The appointments to positions and promotion must be based solely on merit.

Restraint from using school contracts and privileges to promote partisan politics, sectarian religious views, or self promotion of any kind.

Direct constructive criticisms of any department of the school system toward the improvement of the schools is to be made directly to the school administrator who has the administrative responsibility for improving the situation and then to the superintendent if necessary.

The proper use and protection of all school properties, equipment, and materials.
