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Administration

Concept and Roles in Administration

The administration of this school system is responsible for directing and coordinating the administrative staff in realizing the educational philosophy, goals and general objectives adopted by the board of education within the guidelines established by board of education policy, law and employee agreements. (cf. Series 1000 -Philosophy-Goals-Objectives)

To demonstrate leadership and to resolve the inevitable problems and obstacles which will arise both inside the school system and in its relations with the community, the board of education expects the administration to specialize in

- 1. the processes of decision making and communication.
- 2. planning, organizing, implementing and evaluating.
- 3. coordinating and guiding the various centers of power within the school system and the community so as to enable people to do things together for education that they might never be able to do separately.

The superintendent of schools is encouraged to conduct the operations of the school system according to the management team concept.
