

StudentsDress and Grooming

The responsibility for the appearance of the students of Brookfield Public Schools rests with parents or legal guardian, and the students themselves.

The parent or legal guardian and student have the right to determine the student's dress providing that such attire is not destructive to school property, complies with the health code and does not interfere with the educational process.

Parents or legal guardian and student should be guided in that clothing should be appropriate and should be neat, clean, inoffensive, and decent. For health reasons, some type of footwear is necessary. Hair should be neat, clean, and well groomed at all times.

This right may not be restricted, even by a dress code arrived at by a majority vote of students.
