Drugs, Alcohol, and Tobacco

Illicit Drugs and Alcohol

There shall be no use, distribution, or unlawful possession of illicit drugs or alcohol in the building, on the grounds, or transportation provided by the Board or at any event, trip or activity sponsored by the school or under the supervision of the Board. The use of prescription and overthe-counter drugs is permitted subject to the restriction and recommendations made by the prescribing physician as set forth in the regulation of 5141.21, Administration of Medication.

Tobacco

There shall be no smoking or other use of tobacco products at any time, by anyone, on school property, on transportation provided by the Board of Education, or during the course of any trip or activities sponsored by the Board or under the supervision of the Board or its authorized agent, as of September 1, 1991.
