

Environmental Concerns

Regulation

The Superintendent shall respond to environmental concerns in the District's facilities in a prompt and open manner. Teachers, parents, students or community members shall communicate environmental concerns directly to the building principal in writing, at the time when the concern surfaces. The building principal shall forward the written concern to the Superintendent within one business day.

The Superintendent shall inform the Board of the receipt of such notification within twenty-four hours.

The Superintendent, the Director of Business and Finance, Supervisor of Buildings and Grounds, Principal and other consultants as needed shall determine if further investigation or action is necessary within forty-eight hours. If action is deemed warranted it shall be taken in a timely manner.

After the concern has been resolved, a report shall be made to the Facilities subcommittee.
