Use of Automatic External Defibrillators (AEDs)

In order to assist individuals who may experience cardiac arrest on school property, the Brookfield Board of Education has acquired external defibrillators for use in school buildings. It is the policy of the Brookfield Board of Education to support the use of these automatic external defibrillators by trained personnel on school property.

The Superintendent or his/her designee shall be responsible for developing administrative regulations in furtherance of the Automatic External Defibrillator (AED) policy, in conformity with the provisions of applicable statutes and regulations.
