

Community Relations

Fund-Raising by Student Groups

Students shall not participate in any organized campaign to raise funds in, on or about the school grounds, nor may teachers permit such campaigns or drives within their classrooms, except such drives or campaigns which are sponsored by the school.

The following activities may be conducted by student council, classes or school sponsored clubs and must have the prior approval of the building administrator:

1. School Store Sales
 - Stationary
 - Paperbacks
 - School spirit items
 - Snacks (perhaps through the partial use of vending machines)
2. Admissions or Subscriptions
 - Dances
 - Plays
 - Concerts
 - Talent shows
 - Sports activities
 - Fashion shows
 - School newspapers
 - Yearbook
 - Magazines
3. Service Projects or Auctions
 - Car washes
 - Food Sales
 - Student art or other auctions
4. Solicitation of Advertising
 - Yearbook
 - Brookfield High School approved newspaper
5. Miscellaneous Activities
 - School or class picnic days
 - Movies for students
 - Special field trips

Any other fund-raising activity by the students shall be approved by the Superintendent.
