

BusinessGifts, Grants and Bequests

The Board of Education may receive and accept or refuse any grant, gift or donation of money or personal property to be used for the educational benefit of students. All such gifts, grants, and donations shall become the property of the school district.

The Superintendent shall set criteria for accepting or refusing and procedures for distributing gifts or donations to district schools or educational programs.
