Goals and Objectives in Community Relations

The Brookfield Board of Education has established the following goals governing the relationship between the school and the greater Brookfield Community:

1. To regularly and thoroughly inform the members of the school community of all policies, programs, and plans of the district and when appropriate to encourage community involvement in their development.
2. To obtain the advice and counsel of the public especially at all Board of Education meetings.
3. To obtain broad community participation on ad hoc advisory committees.
4. To develop community understanding of the need for adequate resources and support.
5. To encourage community responsibility for the quality of the educational programs.
6. To invite the assistance, cooperation and understanding of elected and appointed town officials and committees in the development of educational programs and facilities.
7. To survey the attitude of the public regarding their schools.
8. To earn the good will, respect and trust of members of the community.
9. To maintain an effective telecommunications system between the schools and the community.
10. To maintain effective communications with the community through local media.
