Community Relations

Goals and Objectives in Community Relations

The Brookfield Board of Education has established the following goals governing the relationship between the school and the greater Brookfield Community:

- 1. To regularly and thoroughly inform the members of the school community of all policies, programs, and plans of the district and when appropriate to encourage community involvement in their development.
- To obtain the advice and counsel of the public especially at all Board of Education meetings.
- 3. To obtain broad community participation on ad hoc advisory committees.
- 4. To develop community understanding of the need for adequate resources and support.
- 5. To encourage community responsibility for the quality of the educational programs.
- 6. To invite the assistance, cooperation and understanding of elected and appointed town and committees in the development of educational programs and facilities.
- 7. To survey the attitude of the public regarding their schools.
- 8. To earn the good will, respect and trust of members of the community.
- 9. To maintain an effective telecommunications system between the schools and the community.
- 10. To maintain effective communications with the community through local media.
