Participation in Work Programs

Guidelines

Students, with approval of the school administration, may be employed during the hours when school is in session under one or more of the following conditions:

- the student is a participant in a school authorized work study or work experience program;
- parental permission is obtained;
- special education I.E.P. requires it.

The staff will monitor student progress and, if necessary, curtail or stop any participation in a work program if the student's grades are adversely affected.
