Personnel - Coaches

Intramural or Interscholastic- Regulation

Brookfield coaches will hold teacher certification in the State of Connecticut as required by Statute. At such times when persons holding appropriate certification are unavailable then persons who are not certified may be hired in keeping with State of Connecticut regulations.

In addition to the above coaches must meet the following requirements:

1. Head Coaches must be at least 21 years of age.
2. Assistant Coaches must be high school graduates.
3. Must hold a valid certificate indicating successful completion of First-Aid and C.P.R. training.
4. Hold certificates indicating successful completion and/or participation within the previous three years in workshops relating to:
 - (a) Sports Medicine
 - (b) Care and prevention of athletic injuries.

The Brookfield Board of Education will provide appropriate in-service training at district expense, in basic First-Aid, C.P.R., Sports Medicine and Care and Prevention of Athletic Injuries.

Head Coaches and Assistant Coaches who are certificated teachers and have coached in Brookfield Public Schools as of the date of adoption of these Regulations by the Board of Education, shall have one year in which to meet the above requirements.
