## **Community Relations**

Possession of Firearms on School Property

Persons other than law enforcement officers including school resource officers (SROs) are prohibited by the Board of Education from possessing firearms for any reasons, whether otherwise lawful or not, in or on the real property comprising the school district or at a school-sponsored activity including activities conducted on or off school property.

Students are prohibited by the Board from possessing firearms for any reason, whether otherwise lawful or not, in or on the real property comprising the school district or at a school-sponsored activity including activities conducted on or off school property, or on any transportation to and from school, and/or to and from a school sponsored activity in either public or private transportation.
