Personnel - Non-Certified

Retirement

Any non-certificated employee may retire under provisions of any pension or retirement plan or system provided for state or municipal employees at the option of the employee.

Any non-certificated employee who attains the age of seventy (70) may be retired at that date unless otherwise specified by the provisions of the pension or retirement plan.
