School Census

In accordance with state law, the board shall annually determine by age the number of children of compulsory school age who reside within the jurisdiction of the school district as of January 1st of each year. The Brookfield Board of Education approves the traditional door-to-door method of enumeration.

In addition, the board of education instructs the superintendent to receive a count of resident students from non-public schools from the state department of education, and to canvass various town offices, community agencies, and other local sources (e.g., the police, town clerk, welfare department, counseling services, chamber of commerce, welfare offices, parents, real estate offices, utilities, etc.)
