

StudentsStudent Driving/Parking

Since the Brookfield Board of Education provides school buses for student transportation, has limited parking space and supports the national need to conserve energy, the use of automobiles or other motor driven vehicles by students to get to and from the Brookfield Public Schools during the regular academic sessions is prohibited unless the student has been granted special permission.

In situations involving a working student, a special family need or a one-time problem, permission for student use of an automobile may be granted by the building administrator at the request of the parent or legal guardian.

Students bringing vehicles to school part time or full time, must have their vehicles registered at the school office.
