Student Production of Services and Materials

Income from School Shop Sales and Services

Items made in shop, art, home economics or other classes in the Brookfield Public Schools of school-furnished materials that are not needed for school purposes may be offered for sale through school programs and shall not be considered as profit-producing for the district.

Customers shall be charged on the basis of material used, any parts used, and incidental costs of providing the product or service. All money received from customers shall be turned in each day to the building administrator or designee and shall be deposited in the appropriate student activity fund.
