

Non-Instructional Operations

Student Supplying Own Transportation

In situations where the student supplies his/her own transportation to a school or other place of education outside the Town of Brookfield, where the town is required by law to provide transportation, the student shall be compensated at the rate up to the dollar limit required by state law. A student must supply a certificate of insurance and waiver of claim against the Town of Brookfield or the Board of Education for him/herself and any passengers therein when application is made for compensation.

Any passenger transported by a student must have his/her parent or legal guardian sign a written consent and submit it to the office of the Business Manager. If the passenger is 18 years or older, he/she may sign the consent form himself/herself.

No compensation shall be allowed where transportation is routinely provided.
