

Personnel - CertificatedSubstitute Teachers

A substitute teacher shall be a person fully qualified to instruct in our schools and who is employed for short periods of time in the absence of the regular teacher.

Suitable programs for training, assigning, orienting, and evaluating the work of substitute teachers shall be provided by the certificated staff under the direction of the superintendent.

Rates of compensation for substitute teachers will be set by the board of education.

Substitute teachers will not participate in the health and welfare plans or other fringe benefits of the school system.

Retired teachers may be employed as substitute teachers without jeopardizing their retirement salary within the limits as prescribed by law.

Public Act 82-401 - provides that a retired teacher may be employed temporarily in a public teaching position on the condition that he/she receive no more than compensation of 45% of the entry level salary for such position.
