BHS + ECE Courses = Potential College Credit!

UCONN tuition for one semester is approximately:

\$10,000!

1 semester = 15-18 credits

ECE credits awarded for a final grade of C or better *as calculated by UCONN standards

3 credits cost \$145**
4 credits cost \$180**

** includes \$20 program fee



AP credits are different for each college and are generally awarded for scores of 4 or 5 only, based on the AP exam

Test cost: \$91

Why might you take an ECE course if you are already enrolled in an AP course and must take the AP exam?

If you are not a strong test taker and are a stronger classroom performer, the ECE class may be a better option. Ask your teacher or counselor!


You must complete this form to apply online to be accepted as an ECE student by UCONN and eligible to register for a course.
