Students with Communicable Diseases

~~The Board of Education recognizes that children afflicted with a communicable disease have a right to receive a public education.~~

~~The Board has established procedural guidelines for dealing with the problem which will:~~

~~ensure that each afflicted child receives a public education in accordance with current law;~~

~~provide information for parents, faculty members and other necessary persons concerning the actual or potential dangers of transmission of the disease;~~

~~ensure that appropriate decisions and actions are based on current medical knowledge;~~

~~place restrictions upon the child to the extent necessary to minimize the risk of transmitting the disease; and~~

~~provide protection for the rights of privacy of each afflicted child.~~
