Students with Communicable Diseases

The Board of Education recognizes that children afflicted with a communicable disease have a right toreceive a public education.

The Board has established procedural guidelines for dealing with the problem which will:

ensure that each afflicted child receives a public education in accordance with current law;

provide information for parents, faculty members and other necessary personsconcerning the actual or potential dangers of transmission of the disease;

ensure that appropriate decisions and actions are based on current medical knowledge;

place restrictions upon the child to the extent necessary to minimize the risk of transmitting the disease: and

provide protection for the rights of privacy of each afflicted child.
