Subject: January 2024 Financial Report

Attached is the January 2024 Financial Report. As reported in previous months, there are several line items where I anticipate variances to budget and, based on the information currently available, I am projecting a budget shortfall of approximately \$493K.

We continue to see overages in special education and substitute costs, which are partially offset by excess cost grant revenue and salary savings due to leaves and vacancies. Unrealized teacher turnover savings, athletic transportation, water at CLES and VoAg tuition contribute to the shortfall as well. I am also now reporting a shortfall in electricity due to an underestimated cost provided by engineers when this year's budget was developed. After assessing the needs of the remaining year, a budget freeze has been placed on several accounts in order to help cover this shortfall.
