Instruction

Emergencies and Disaster Preparedness

All employees of the school system are responsible for doing everything in their power to promote the safety of all of the students at all times.

The administration shall require the building principal to maintainworking regulations and procedures for fire, bomb threats, civildefense, and other emergencies.

Every effort shall be made to maintain the fire alarm system, regular and emergency exits, fire prevention measures, and a sensitivity among students and employees to the importance of smooth working emergency procedures.

<u>First</u> Aid

The administration is to be responsible for seeing that at least one person at each school site is trained in. first aid.
