## Non-Instructional Operations

## Free or Reduced Price Lunches

The district shall take part in the National School Lunch and other food programs which may become available to assure ensure that all students in the district receive proper nourishment. In accordance with the guidelines for participation in these programs and in accordance with the wishes eligibility criteria of the Board of Education, no student shall be denied a free lunch or other food simply because proper application has not been received from his or her parent(s) or legal guardian.
