- 3) Student Achievement Presentation Review-Dr. Mahon and Mrs. Farias presented a preview of the annual spring testing results (on SBA, NGSS, and SAT student achievement). Through the presentation, they reviewed student achievement results, compared cohorts or results from the 2022 spring administration, discussed what can be gleaned, what the district is implementing and how individual schools are using the information to help inform school improvement plans.
- 4) Update on curriculum, instruction, and assessment practices
 - a) AP Statistics textbook update-No changes in text, only an updated version of the currently-approved title.
 - b) Professional development day 10/9-Dr. Mahon reported on the professional learning sessions. This was the first official day of PD Pathway work as well as some specific IM professional learning for teachers of grades 3-5, required annual teacher training through the Global Compliance Network (GCN) platform, and DESSA screening completion by teachers.
 - c) PDEC work-Dr. Mahon reported on the upcoming work of the Professional Development and Evaluation Committee, which includes the implementation of the PD Pathways and the creation of

an entirely new teacher evaluation system(that is predicated on growth and support) for the 2024-2025 school year.
