RE: Brookfield Homeschool Report

The following is intended to provide members of the Brookfield Board of Education and the public information regarding the number of school-aged children who are currently being homeschooled.

Parents of students for whom we have knowledge of homeschool status are sent letters and “Notice of Intent for Instruction of Student at Home” forms in the summer. In the letter, we request parents to complete the form and return it to the district. This notice is a “suggested procedure” as outlined in the C-14 Guidelines for Suggested Procedures for Home Instruction. Home Instruction is described in Connecticut General Statute 10-184.

Currently available data reveals that there are **29** students being homeschooled in Brookfield. The **29** students identified as being homeschooled come from **24** Brookfield families. For the **29** students for whom we have information regarding home school status, **5** “Notice of Intent” forms were completed and returned. Parents of **24** students did not respond to the request for information. For **3** students, parents sent letters of refusal to complete the form. The information obtained via completed “Intent” forms completed and letters received from parents and other data available yield the following information on our 2022-2023 homeschool student sample:
