Subject: HHES furniture and equipment disposal plan

In accordance with BOE Policy 3260 Sales and Disposal of Obsolete Books, Equipment, and Supplies, the Superintendent is authorized to dispose of any items having a value of less than \$5,000. Adhering to the guidelines stated in the policy, the following is our plan to address furniture and equipment that will not be transferred to Candlewood Lake Elementary School.

- All computers/technology equipment of any value will be inventoried for spares or parts.
- BHS/WMS/TSO will have first choice on furniture and equipment.
- Town agencies will be notified and can take furniture and equipment free of charge.
- Surplus furniture and equipment, not taken by the schools or town agencies, can be sold or donated to the public or disposed of if there is no value.
- Community groups and organizations have preference over individuals.
- Employees have an equal but not preferential opportunity to purchase the furniture and equipment.
