The State of Connecticut received \$16 million of federal American Rescue Plan Act funds to be allocated to school districts, who participate in the National School Lunch Program (NSLP). These funds will be used to provide one lunch meal per school day free of charge to students who are eligible for REDUCED-PRICE meals.
