## PSAT Score Release

PSAT Scores will be available online for Connecticut students beginning Monday, December 9th. All 9th through 11th grade students should access their scores by:

1. Logging into their College Board Account if they've already created one OR
2. Creating a College Board Account if they haven't already

## Logging Into Your College Board Account

- 10th and llth grade students should have created accounts.
- Go to collegeboard.org to log in.
- Use the Forgot username or password if you do not remember your log in information. Try both your school and personal emails before creating a new account. College Starts Here
