Student Support and Engagement



- o <u>Visible</u> in classrooms, hallways, cafeteria, and arrival/dismissal
- Collaborative with teacher/counselor/nurse/admin for <u>student support interventions</u> (academic, socially, behavior, attendance, etc.)
- Accessible to engage with students individually or small group to be <u>proactive</u> before conflict arises
- Supportive in <u>developmental guidance lessons</u> with school counselors
- Participate in planning and coordinating engaging co-curricular activities and establish
 <u>expectations</u> for student attendance, conduct, and learning performance aligned to RULER
- Consistent <u>support for staff</u> to be proactive in interactions with students and families attend weekly team meetings
- Shared responsibility with Principal, Assistant Principal, and School Climate Leadership Team for the safety, health, and welfare of students.

Family Connections

- Maintain <u>positive</u>, <u>ongoing communication</u> and relations with WMS families
- Ensure families experience a sense of <u>welcome and belonging</u>
- > Promote shared accountability for students' academic and behavioral performance
- Coordinate regular, timely <u>communication with families</u> regarding student conduct and academic achievement
- Respond to family concerns promptly and effectively
- Communicate and meet with families regarding student conduct and find ways to improve behavior
- Organize <u>family learning opportunities</u> for MS families around academic expectations, social media, pre-adolescent development in MS, parenting tips, etc.
- Plan and coordinate the 6th grade student orientation with families and with CLES staff and administration
- Liaison to <u>community organizations</u> that can help to support our students and families





Daily School Operations

- Supervision of cafeteria lunch waves (3) and arrival/dismissal
- Manage everyday <u>behavioral issues</u> initiate <u>bullying</u> investigations follow up with appropriate consequence including restorative practices and communicating with families, staff and paperwork as part of due process
- Collect data (formal/informal) regarding school climate, culture, and the support structures to improve existing structures and overall school climate and culture
- Collaborate with staff on <u>intervention</u> systems and <u>engagement</u> opportunities for students including after school non-athletic activities
- Facilitate implementation of <u>restorative practices</u> and oversee detention issues
- <u>Crisis Support</u> consistent leadership and collaboration with administration and mental health staff
- Work with the Administration and School Resource Officer to maintain safety and build relationships with students and parents



Current Status

<u>Currently - 5th/6th Grade Assistant Principal</u>

- 380 students about 190 6th graders will remain
- Supervises 17 teachers 10 teachers will remain at WMS. 47 teachers (2 admin)
- Evaluation adds 20 meetings (goals, mid-year, review of practice, end of year) and 10-15 observations
- Supervises 5th and 6th grade lunch waves 6th grade will remain
- Coordinates substitutes and the many coverages needed during the day
- Weekly meetings with 5th and 6th grade (4 teams)
- Responsible for 5th and 6th grade discipline
- Student scheduling and staff assignments
- Benchmark and SBA Testing
- 5th Grade Student Orientation and Family Night
- 5th/6th Grade SRBI
