

French Honor Society (FHS) at Brookfield High School

The aim of this organization shall be to stimulate interest in the study of French, to promote high standards of scholarship, to reward scholastic achievements, to create enthusiasm for and an understanding of Francophone cultures, and to promote international friendship (frenchteachers.org)

Nomination Criteria

1. The student is in the 10th grade or above, currently enrolled in French and has achieved a grade of 93% or above in the study of this language in semester 1 of the current year and in the prior year of study.

2. The student has achieved a MINIMUM GPA of 3.5 at the time of nomination.

3. Nomination is made by the student's current French teacher based on the grade criteria above, and the teacher's assessment of how the student demonstrates through his/her character, class engagement and interest that acquiring and applying the French language and culture as a life skill (beyond just an academic subject).

4. Seniors qualifying for the first time will be nominated during the second quarter of their senior year. Upon approval of their application, they will be able to participate in the club as of the first meeting after acceptance.

5. Tenth and eleventh graders qualifying during the current school year will be nominated during the second semester. Upon approval of their application, they will be inducted during the awards ceremony in June, and can start participating in the club as of the first meeting of the following school year.
