After having been nominated to apply based on the criteria for each language stated here <https://www.brookfield.k12.ct.us/world-language/bhs-world-language/pages/national-language-honor-societies> nominees will need to submit an application before the indicated deadline in their email invitation.

Application guidelines

The application consists of the following two items:

1. **Essay:** If you are considering membership, please compose an essay (in French or in Spanish, no more than 200 words, double-spaced, size 12 Times New Roman font) where you respond to the following questions:
 - 1) What contribution(s) would you bring to the Honor Society?
 - 2) What are your long-term goals/aspirations with French or Spanish?

2. **Recommendation:** As part of your membership consideration, the World Language team would like to review a recommendation by an adult, who is not part of your family and not a BHS WL teacher, who you admire (teacher, coach, mentor, administrator, boss). Please have her/him complete and sign a letter of recommendation (in English) responding to this prompt:

In no more than 100 words, please share how this student demonstrates her/his interest in and/or enthusiasm for French/Spanish culture.
