On June 17th the Brookfield Board of Education and Superintendent of Schools published its <u>value statement</u> regarding race, diversity and equity. The Board of Education is currently accepting applications for core members for this Equity and Inclusion subcommittee. This subcommittee will focus on how to affect positive change for our school community.

The Board is seeking inclusive representation from stakeholders including our BPS staff, students, families and interested community members.
