



French Honor Society of Brookfield High School

The aim of this organization shall be to stimulate interest in the study of French, to promote high standards of scholarship, to reward scholastic achievements, to create enthusiasm for and an understanding of Francophone cultures, and to promote international friendship (frenchteachers.org)

Admission Criteria

French language students are eligible for nomination to the French Honor Society if he/she is in the 10th grade or above, currently enrolled in French and has maintained a 90% or above in French in ALL of the previous three semesters before nomination, as well as an overall GPA of 3.5 at the time of nomination.

Nomination is made by the student's current French teacher based on the grade criteria above. Nominated students will be notified by the FHS advisor requesting acceptance of nomination. The student then needs to accept the nomination in order to be inducted in the club.

Typically, tenth and eleventh graders qualifying during the current school year will be inducted during the school-wide awards ceremony in June, and can start participating in the club as of the first meeting of the following school year. However, seniors qualifying for the first time will be inducted during the second semester of their senior year, and can participate in the club as of the first meeting after confirmation of induction.
